PRE-SOLICITATION NOTICE Solicitation No. SGE500-13-R-0098

The Regional Procurement Support Office intends to issue a request for proposal (RFP) under full and open competition for numerous PEPFAR construction and supply and installation of pre-fabricated structures throughout Zimbabwe on behalf of the U.S. Department the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Zimbabwe.

It is the Government's intention to award multiple indefinite-delivery indefinite-quantity (IDIQ) construction contracts for the supply and installation of pre-fabricated structures throughout Zimbabwe. The Contracts will be for one base and four option years. Each contract includes related coordination with local health minister, utility authorities and other companies as required to complete the project. Each contractor awarded an IDIQ contract will be given fair consideration (as defined by the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 16.505 (b) (1)) for award of the individual projects by task order. Performance of services will be at various sites throughout Zimbabwe. Most individual projects will be in the range of \$175,000 to \$250,000 U.S. dollars.

Potential contractors shall be in possession of all required permits and licenses to perform general construction work in Zimbabwe. The pre-proposal conference and site visit date and location/s will be provided with the solicitation package, the pre-proposal conference and site visit will be held sometime in early November, 2013. All communication, correspondence, and documentation shall be in English. Any translations desired by offerors must be made at their own expense. The contract shall be governed by U.S. laws and regulations.

The solicitation will be issued on or about October 14, 2013. Contract award is planned for late November or early December 2013, the solicitation package will contain the first fifteen (15) locations of approximately three hundred (300) individual pre-fabricated structures at different locations throughout Zimbabwe. It is the US Governments intent to award the remaining locations via task order to the companies receiving the award of the indefinite-delivery indefinite-quantity (IDIQ) contracts.
